

What's Appropriate at Camp?

What do you think? After each question, write a number (0,1,2,3,4,5) that signifies how appropriate each scenario is.

The scale: 0= never appropriate and 5=it's ok!

1. By the end of the first day of camp, it is apparent that 3-4 of the kids are quite "needy" and want to hang on the counselors all the time.
2. During free time, several 6th grade girls track down a group of boys and their counselors. They tease each other, & the girls end up sitting on the counselor's laps.
3. One of the male counselors sits by the same boy at every meal, every campfire.
4. Mindy, a counselor, sits on her bunk bed in the evening in her underwear, in full view of campers as they get ready for bed.
5. John, age 18, challenges each of his 5th grade campers to a leg wrestling match.
6. Amy, a counselor, tells her campers about her first kiss.
7. During a rain storm, the whole camp gathers inside and several summer staff give each other backrubs to relax.
8. After lights out, a counselor goes outside by himself to "check on things around the camp."
9. Two counselors, Jenny and Max, like each other and have moved beyond hand holding to being joined at the hip when they walk and sit. Their arms are frequently around each other.
10. Gary, a summer staffer has been heard to remark on the physical appeal of some of the girls. He has used such terms as "babe," "hottie," and "adorable."
11. Jake, a counselor seen as a real spiritual leader agrees to meet individually with campers of both genders for prayer.
12. Annie, a counselor suggests that there be a dance with slow music after campfire. She thinks the boys need to learn how to slow dance, so they won't be embarrassed at school dances.
13. During shower time, the counselor notes that some of the campers do not want to undress in front of others. The counselor comments, "Come on, don't you want to show us what kind of a man you are?"
14. Kate feels bad for her homesick campers and rubs their backs until they fall asleep in their bunks.
