

Questions for discerning appropriate behavior at camp:

Whenever you engage in any activities, keep in mind the following questions:

1. Would I be willing to be held responsible for having taught or encouraged this activity?
2. How will this activity make the camper feel about their camp experience, about you as a leader, and about themselves?
3. Do you have the best interests of the camper in mind?
4. Would the campers' parents or pastor approve?
5. Are you violating any personal or touch boundaries?
6. How safe is the activity?
7. Is this activity or these words necessary to make camp successful?
